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Workgroup Discussion: Privacy and Security Priority Target Area



- Potential HITAC Activities Identified by Workgroup to Date
 - » Opportunity: Increased uniformity of information sharing policies across states. For example, address implications of the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018.
 - Suggested HITAC Activity: Consider federal role in setting guidelines for exchange of data across states
 - » Opportunity: Support for widespread adoption of cybersecurity framework(s)
 - Suggested HITAC Activity: Consider impact of nationwide adoption of cybersecurity framework(s)
 - Suggested HITAC Activity: Delineate cybersecurity accountability for data by role

- Other Opportunities Covered During Deeper Dive
 - » Opportunity: Consider what to regulate about the Internet of Things (IoT)
 - Problem to Solve: "IoT turns data that previously was mostly static into data that is in motion most of the time....There are no governance structures or policies or frameworks or agreements or legal boundaries or anything around data in motion." (from NCVHS report, p. 53)
 - Suggested HITAC Activity: TBD
 - » Opportunity: Address implications of European Union's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and Privacy Shield
 - Problem to Solve: Should the U.S. establish more privacy rules for health record keepers currently not covered by HIPAA as data is exchanged? (from NCVHS report, pp. 46-47)
 - Suggested HITAC Activity: TBD



- Other Opportunities Covered During Deeper Dive (continued)
 - » Opportunity: Granular levels of consent to share and disclose information
 - Problems to Solve: Current consent form collection and storage practices are static and not aligned with data in motion, i.e., consent should flow with the data; the design and use of consent forms need to become more user-centered
 - Suggested HITAC Activity: Undertake a review of emerging consent approaches and the technologies that underpin them and make recommendations for improvement of current consent approaches
 - » Opportunity: Support for and education of technology users regarding privacy and security protections, including for health and other information shared on social media
 - Problem to Solve: While social media platforms can enable collaboration, users are also vulnerable to privacy breaches and misuse of their health information
 - Suggested HITAC Activity: Identify educational approaches, technological mitigators, and potential regulatory solutions that offer improved privacy and security protections



- Other Opportunities Identified by Workgroup for Further Consideration
 - » Education about HIPAA and Confidentiality of Substance Use Disorder Patient Records (a.k.a. 42 CFR Part 2) regulation implications
 - » Continue to improve patient matching when sharing data
