Additional Potential Topics for HITAC Discussion in 2022 HITAC Feedback

- Improving Interoperability of Lab Order and Lab Result Data
- Intersection of Clinical and Administrative Data (ICAD) (e.g. ePrior Authorization)
- Bidirectional Exchange for Public Health: Datasets and Standards, HIEs and HINs
- SDOH Data: Standards Development, Standardized Data Across Agency Programs, Barriers to Exchange
 - Better define SDOH data and ensure interoperability between SDOH data and patient records
- EHRs and Patient Safety
- Data Standards and Exchange to Support Behavioral Health, Mental Health, and Substance Abuse Disorders
- FHIR Standards Advancements
 - Consider patient-generated health data and the ability to make that data available by looking at FHIR Write Access to the EHR or View Access from the EHR (out to another app)
- Industry Interoperability Measurement Opportunities
