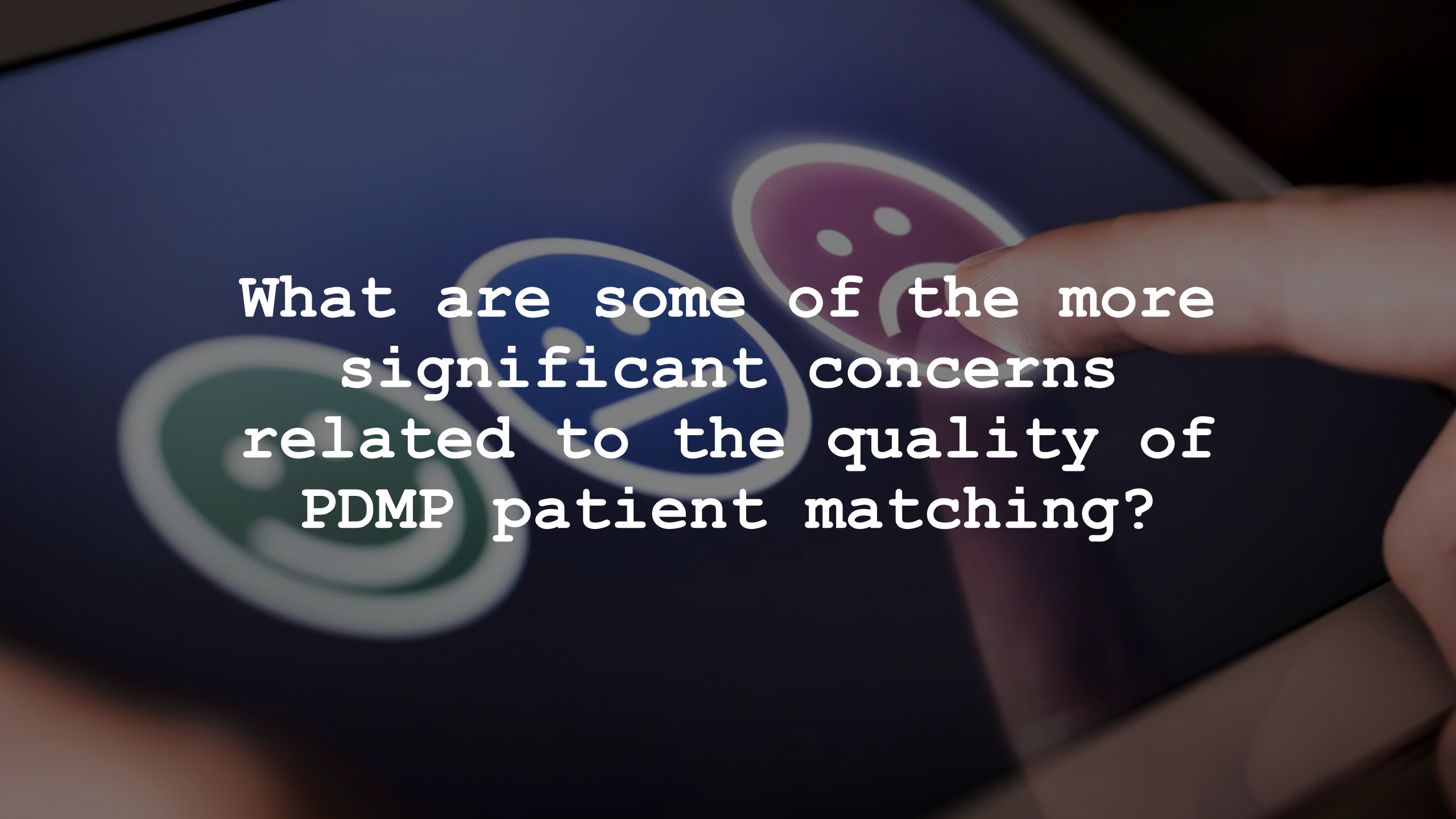

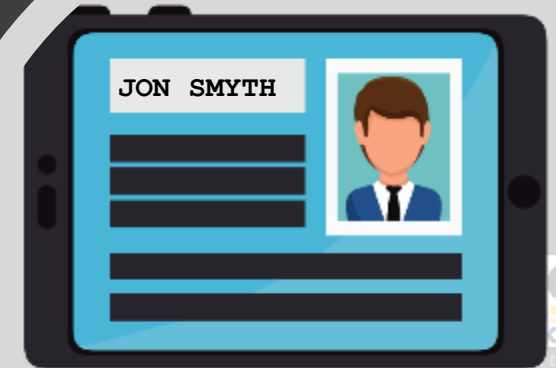
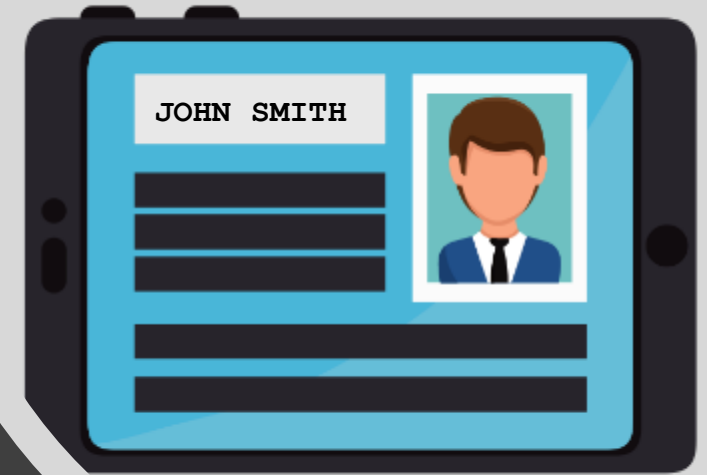
Challenges

- Lack of consistency with disparate data sources
- Marital status changes
- Twins
- ID or person dropping off/picking up

- Lack of standardization
- Lack of understanding

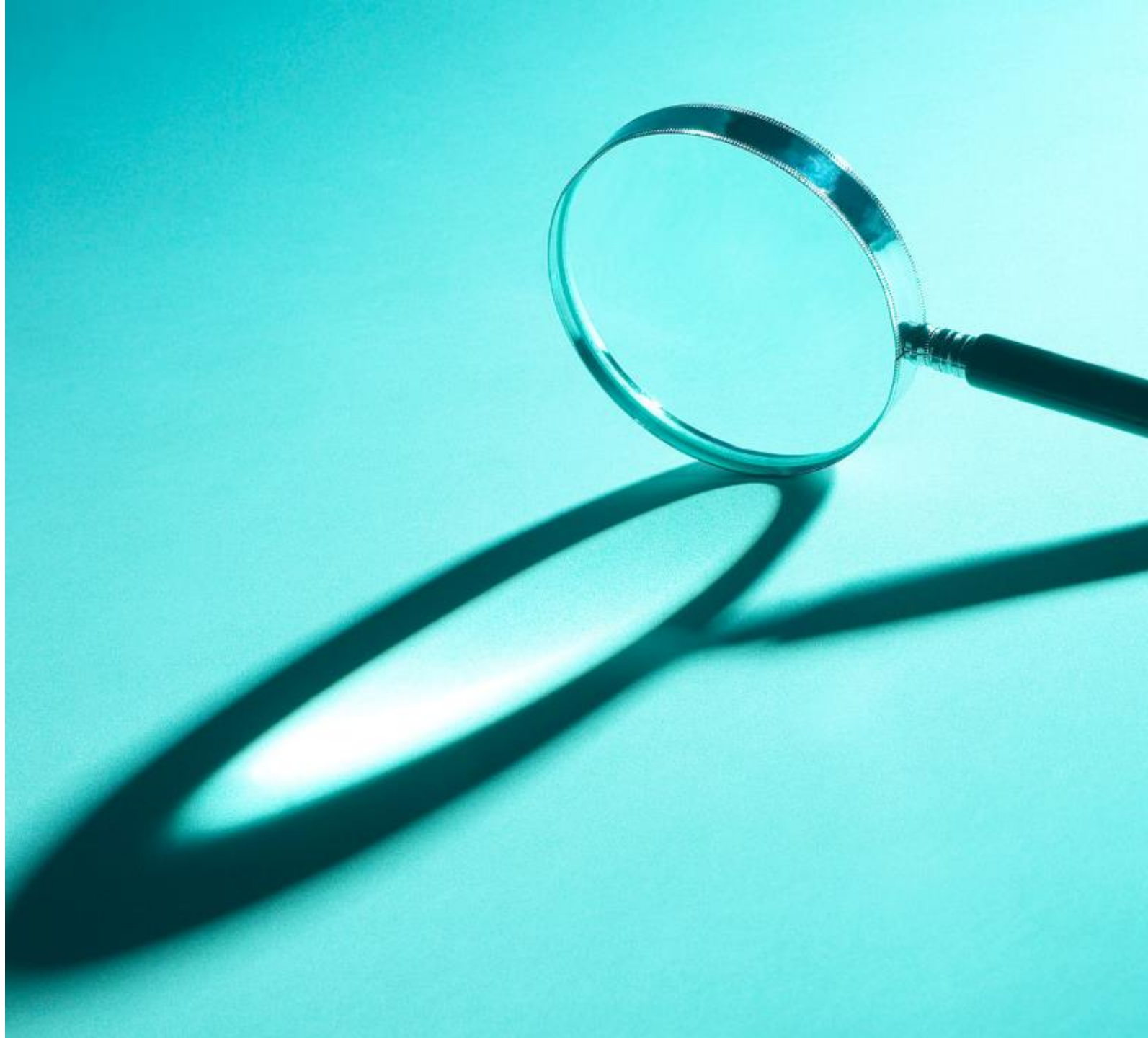


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What are some benefits

- Search requirements
- eMPI solution upstream from data processing within PDMP
- Match EHR, HIE with PDMPs
- Other innovative methods
- ASAP patient ID





Opportunities

- Studies to identify, improve gaps
- SUPPORT Act
 - Sec. 7161
 - Sec. 5042 - Medicaid PARTNERSHIP Act

Qualified PDMP

- Check PDMP before prescribing controlled substance
- Allows access by state Medicaid program
- Interoperability
 - Facilitates integration into the workflow of a covered provider
 - Provides access to share data with contiguous state
 - Requires accurate and complete patient match

Medicaid PARTNERSHIP Act (Sec. 5042)
